Dear Charlie,

Concerning our meeting this AM ....

I ADAMANTLY deny all the accusations .....

On October 26th the date of the first accusation I hosted a parish Halloween pot-luck supper & Party in the Parish Hall. Before the party I hosted two married couples for supper. Since I do not know the time of the alleged incident, this is what was happening in the evening.

Since no date was given for the alleged february incident .... I can only denu the truth of the allegation. Yet it was reported to have happened when bos-02 was brought to me for help by her parents. It is my recollection that was not may parents who first alerted me to her "crisis". It was a school chum, Ms may may in trouble. At this time I learned that may was dabbling in witchcraft, Wica & Oulja Boards etc. She had done some cutting and was in a dark mood. I alerted the parents to what I perceived as suicidal ideation: was admitted to a clinic in Pembroke & I volunteered to be available to school counselors.

I ask ... If I had perpetrated these crimes would I have referred her for help where my actions would have been revealed?

Regarding the allegation on March 17th .... the incident was supposed to have occurred in my second floor room (s) .... At that time I was living on the first floor .... there were two other priests Fr. John Swenski & Fr Bill Lucey and a deacon, Joseph Arsenault living in the house (on the second floor). Furthermore, I am a serious heart patient, taking twenty-three pills a day .... the alleged act would have been impossible for me due the effects of my medication, Also during this time period my step mother was dying and I frequently at the hospital with her

Upon her release from the hospital ... The revealed to me in front of Mitchell that she had a dream about me attacking her .... I counseled that

was absurd but it must have been scary ... unfortunately I did nothing further about that revelation ....

She and description continued to call the office frequently and manufacture excuses to talk with me ... check with my former secretary, Mrs Louise Scipione .... I considered it teenage infatuation ... and treated it lightly.

I have spoken with and she has many memories which corroborate my recollection. She feels that her daughter would be willing to address these memories. My former Secretary Mrs Sciplone and housekeeper, Mrs Medeiros have corroborating recollections concerning these events.

WELL .... I witnessed her marriage and baptized her first child ... I declined to hire her at my parish in the role of youth minister & I declined to recommend her to her present assignment. I judged her to be flighty, unrealistic & in need of constant approval. She also, in my estimation would assume more authority than would be appropriate. She would have difficulty collaborating or working within a "chain of command" since she would initiate without consultation. She also had a tendency to over-commit with sketchy follow-through. All this I observed while she was a volunteer Religious Ed teacher within our confirmation program. A former pastor in Brooklyn (Monsignor Breen) concurred with these views. In short I did not see her qualified for this sensitive position & I told Fr. McDermott, Pastor of Immaculate Conception Parish. my views.

I realize this response is sketchy but it represents the main points of our meeting today. It is the best I can manage at this time.

I am eager to cooperate & expedite this matter.
